students in effect have more power than either fac or admin.

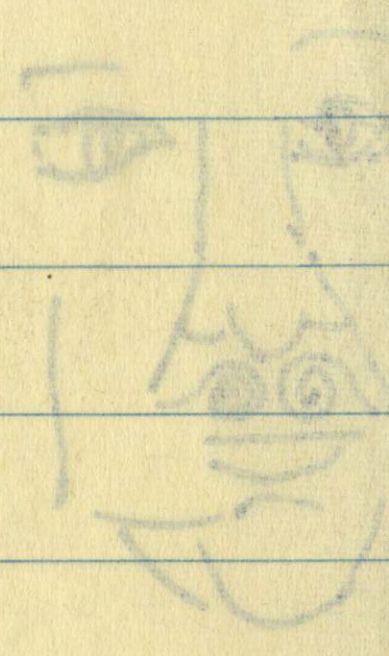
3. Rumors re strike - Use mass media, ^{to say:} will meet on Monday
