


# Save Hostos



On March 25 the COMMUNITY COALITION TO SAVE HOSTOS took over Hostos Community College. The school is open and classes are being held as usual.

The COMMUNITY COALITION TO SAVE HOSTOS is made up of Hostos students, teachers, college workers and community organizations.

The take over was decided when the Board of Higher Education announced that it had informally agreed to close the school down permanently.

Our demands are: 1) SAVE HOSTOS.... 2) Restoration of open admission programs, 3) Assure permanency of free tuition, 4) No more cuts on our budget, restoration of funds that have been taken away, 5) No "mergings" with other colleges.

Education is our right in the struggle for community survival. Hostos at an annual cost of less than \$ 1 million serves one of the city's poorest areas and prepares students for useful jobs and community leadership.
