Total number of students registered 113

Of these, 75 attend full time during the Day, and 38 attend part time in the Evening.

Approximately 60% to 70% are Negro students, 20% to 25% are Puerto Ricans, 10% are white.

There are approximately as many girls as boys.

Programs for full time Day students cover 17 to 18 weekly clock hours of classes:

English (5 weekly class hours); Mathematics (3 or 4) or Foreign Language (3 or 4); Speech (4); Music (3) or Art (2); Physical Education (2).

In addition, each student attends weekly guidance conferences, and, as required, a course of instruction in remedial reading.

Programs for part-time Evening students cover 8 to 9 weekly clock hours of class:

English (5 weekly class hours); Math (3 or 4) or Foreign Language (3 or 4), in addition to which, weekly guidance conferences and instruction in remedial reading are provided.

Enrolments in courses scheduled exclusively for pre-baccalaureate students total 266.

English Composition (Day & Evening) 113; Elementary French (Day) 14, (Eve.) 10; Elementary Spanish (Day) 16, (Eve.) 13; Math Review (Day) 13, (Eve.) 12; Speech 1 (Day) 75.

Pre-baccalaureate enrolments in various sections of regularly scheduled college courses total 176.

Art 1, 41 enrolments (in 19 different Day sections); Music 1, 33 enrolments (in 11 different Day sections); Phys. Ed. (women) 46 enrolments (in 6 different Day sections); Phys. Ed. (men) 24 enrolments (in 9 different sections)

25 pre-baccalaureate students were permitted to enroll by the Department of Romance Languages in regularly scheduled college courses in French and Spanish. 7 received similar approval by the Department of Mathematics and are enrolled in Math 43, 61, 42 and 1.
