Dear Dave:

In light of the opposition to providing funds for the operation of an office for the Negotiating Team of the Bedford-Stuyvesant Coalition by some Board members at our meeting last Thursday, I have had conversations with representatives of the Ford Foundation. As a result of these discussions, the Foundation is willing to provide the Coalition with a grant to cover their costs. Thus, it will not be necessary to use the tax levy funds approved at the August 1st meeting. Messrs. Chandler, Burkhardt, and Quero Chiesa concur in this change.

The Ford Foundation grant will not take effect until September 1, 1968, and there will be some minor interim costs which we shall have to cover from University funds.
