Student - we're in our present situation because students haven't been consulted

Marc Spand(?) - Contradiction: fac council app'd Governor's report but refuses students admissions to Fac Council mtg.

How can Pres. conceive of governing this college with all these negative factors present

Bill - We have a gun at our heads

Recs: - Close college until such time as City can offer full coop in providing adequate police resources

If we close, Pres. McM. Should announce this to public and state why

Student : What will be done if school is closed

McM - If campus is closed and vandalism occurs the security guards will call police

Student : Lots of students who have lost time in studies would be willing to have college closed.

Is it possible to get court order to require police to stay on campus

McM - must deal diplomatically with police, they've been very cooperative.

Any responsible for vandal acts should be punished

Bob —

McMurray - Reads telegrams of our SEEK advi. comm. to th. BHE. requesting clarification of SEEK program - policies and procedures. Dwlpt of SEEK college seems to be at variance with SEEK enabling legislation.

Bob - Does this mean Pres. won't respond v.p. to SEEK demands for currc. revision.

McMurray - says he has no authority over curriculum
Rec. that Fac. Council accept 5-6 refs from Stud Assn (appr'd by Brumman) to sit with Fac. Council.

Ad Hoc member - Has no confidence in Brumman's ability to select representative students
workable solution: to request ^{this} entire group be invited to sit with Fac Council
[group includes range from left to right]

Steve Seidenfeld - To get a fairly representative group of students - use this group

McMurray - This is emergency situation, almost like war. Not going to be possible to be fully democratic at all times.

The Ad Hoc has been wonderfully restrained they've been militant but ~~not~~ non-violent and peaceful. Close campus for negotiation
Close campus - discuss basic issues

— If campus is opened, student club leaders should call their members together and urge restraint and discipline.

— Fac Council should get with it — or else there will be even greater trouble in future.
